The Kilbourn Saxophone Quartet, featuring the Eastman School of Music’s Assistant Professor of Saxophone Chein-Kwan Lin, will perform the composition. The members of the quartet are nationally recognized saxophone artists and music educators. They are dedicated to bringing quality saxophone literature to their audiences. Other selections of the performance will include Holst’s “Suite in Eb” and a medley from “Victory at Sea.”

Admission to the concert is a suggested donation of \$7.00 for adults, \$5.00 for seniors, \$3.00 for students, and \$20.00 for a family. Tickets are available from any Perinton Concert Band member or can be purchased at the door on the evening of the concert.
